DESCRIPTION / FUNCTION

Flexicare's Bubble Humidifiers are designed to moisten dry oxygen that is being administered to the patient for inhalation via the nose or mouth. The humidified oxygen reduces the loss of moisture from the mucous membranes and other tissues throughout the patient's respiratory tract.

Sterile water is placed in the bowl of the bubble humidifier. The unit is connected to an oxygen supply and a nasal cannula or similar device, fitted to the patient. A prescribed flow of oxygen is set and bubbled through the sterile water, then passes to the patient.

The device is used in both hospital and home environments.

PRECAUTIONS / WARNINGS

- Do not use if packaging is opened or damaged
- Ensure sterile water is used
- Fill the water up to the MAX WATER line
- Ensure the bubble humidifier is placed on a level surface
- Do not allow the water level to drop below the MIN WATER line
- After use, this product is contaminated waste and may be a potential biohazard.
 Handle and dispose of in accordance with hospital policy and applicable local guidelines and regulations

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SPECIFICATIONS / KEY FEATURES

- Safety Pressure Valve automatically opens at 6psi / 4psi should the outlet line become occluded. This eliminates the risk of over pressures.
- PVC Nipple Diffuser extends the life of the humidifier and eliminates clogging of the diffuser apertures.
- Recessed Connector with Screw Cap Protects connector from accidental damage or breakage.
- Fine Diffuser creates small gas bubbles to maximise surface contact area, providing increased humidification of the oxygen.
- Humidification Rate 60mg/min @ 8 Lpm
- 300ml (300cc) or 400ml (400cc) Capacity Chambers
- Latex Free
