PRODUCT: Williams Oropharyngeal Airways



DESCRIPTION / FUNCTION

Flexicare's Williams Airway is an oropharyngeal airway designed to maintain the patency of a patient's airway through the oral cavity by holding forward the base of the tongue, preventing it falling backwards and obstructing the airway.

The Williams airway also prevents the jaw from closing and allows for the insertion of other devices, e.g. suction catheters. The devices circular lumen allows passage of an ET tube whilst the device is in-situ. The airway is anatomically shaped to allow the pharyngeal distal end to follow the contours of the mouth cavity. The proximal end has a flange held external to the teeth / gums to keep the airway in place, and a bite block portion intended to be located between the teeth / gums.

Williams Airways provide a conduit for fibre-optic guided intubation via an opening on the distal half of the lingual surface.

- Device is embossed on airway providing easy identification of size even if the user is unfamiliar with colour coding
